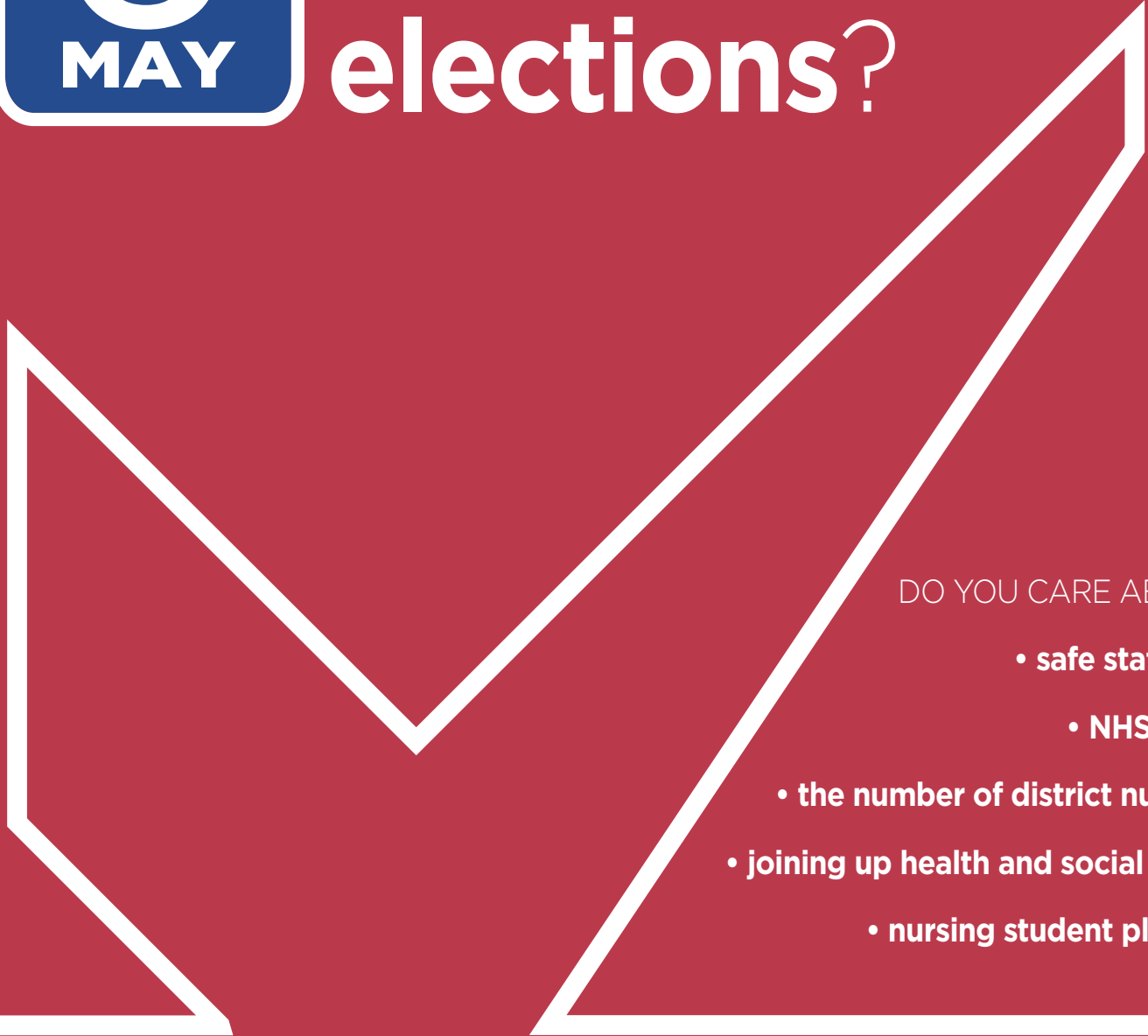

# VOTING in the SENEDD ELECTIONS

All you need to know...

**ELECTION DAY** is Thursday 6th May 2021.

## THEN DECIDE HOW YOU WANT TO VOTE...

### BY POST



You don't need a reason! Find the application form, and where to send it, on the **Electoral Commission website**.

**You can do this up to 5pm on 20th April 2021.**

You'll then received a voting pack from your local council in the in the days leading up to the election.

### BY PROXY



To nominate **someone you trust** to vote in your place, use the Proxy Vote application forms on

**Electoral Commission website** to **apply by 5pm 27th April 2021.**

### IN PERSON



The polling stations are open from **7am to 10pm on Thursday 6th May.**

You don't need your polling card or any ID.

Your polling card tells you **where to go to vote.** You can only vote at your polling station – and it might not be the one nearest to you.

You can also

**search by postcode** for your polling station at the Electoral Commission website.

Alternatively, your local council's Electoral Registration Team can help.

**REMEMBER:** if you're a foreign citizen living in Wales, or a young person aged 16 or over, you can now **REGISTER TO VOTE** and take part in Senedd elections.
